PHOTO DAY

On Saturday April 22nd and Sunday April 23rd, photographs will be taken of each skater in their costume(s). The photos will be taken at Crosby Arena in the Lamplight Room upstairs at Crosby Arena. Both individual and group (Court) photographs will be taken. Our group shot (Court) pictures will be included in our souvenir program that each ticket holder at our Show receives at no extra charge.

During the week of continuity all of the pictures of courts photographs and individual shots will be available for purchase from our photographer, Ernest Ho Photography. Ernest will also be taking random shots of skaters during dress rehearsal and during the show that will then be available via a web-link for your viewing and potential purchase. Due to the large number of skaters in the show these pictures will be of courts on the ice and some random shots.

Ernest Ho will also be attending one or two CanSkate and StarSkate sessions during the Spring Skating sessions to provide an opportunity for purchase of photographs from the show.

Please check the schedule for your skater(s) Court name. As you will see the schedule is very tight with close to 400 skaters in the show. It is imperative that your skater arrives on time as we will not be able to wait if your child is late. The schedule provides you with the time your skater is to be dropped off and the time they will be ready for pick-up.

Please note for the safety of our skaters only those parents who have volunteered to assist with the photo day will be permitted in the dressing rooms and the photograph area. These volunteers will assist all skaters with their costumes and skates.

Upon arrival, parents must register their skater(s) at the registration desk which will be at the FRONT of the arena. Once your child is registered with USC Photography table, One of our volunteers will then escort the skater to their designated dressing room. At the appropriate pick-up time, parents must return to the registration desk to pick-up your child.

Please arrive with hair tired neatly back off their face. Helmets will not be worn in the photos. Please apply make-up (if desired) before you come to the arena and make sure you bring your skates and guards (please label your guards with your child's name!

PLEASE DON'T ARRIVE WITH YOUR CHILD'S SKATES ON as we need to change them into their costume!

- o Check the court list for times of photo for your skater
- o Purchase HARD guards at Figure Skating Boutique or other Skating specialty store for your skater

The time committed is only about one hour and thirty minutes.

Along with dressing room volunteers we are also in need of volunteers that can assist with other jobs on photo day, such as runners, skater security and registration table.
